

Chulalongkorn University Announcement

Admission to the Bachelor of Science in Psychological Science (International Program) Faculty of Psychology for the 2026 Academic Year (International Admission)

Chulalongkorn University is currently open for applications from non-Thai students for the Bachelor of Science in Psychological Science International Program (Joint International Psychology Program) at the Faculty of Psychology for the 2026 Academic Year (International Admission). The specific details are as follows:

1. Application Requirement

Applicants must not hold Thai citizenship and should have either completed high school, passed an equivalent high school standard test, or be in their final year of high school (Grade 12 in the US system or Year 13 in the British system).

- 1.1 Applicants must submit documents covering both of the following qualification criteria:
 - 1.1.1 Applicants must submit score from one of the following English tests:
 - TOEFL (Internet-based) not lower than 88 OR (with a minimum score of 19 for listening, Reading, Speaking and 21 for Writing)
 - IELTS not lower than 6.5 OR (with a minimum score of 6.0 in each sub-band)
 - CU-TEP (Chulalongkorn University Test not lower than 104 of English Proficiency)
 - 1.1.2 Applicants are required to submit scores from one of the following tests:
 - CU- AAT (Academic Aptitude Test of Chulalongkorn University) with the total score from Verbal Section and Math Section

not lower than 1200 OR

not lower than 1200

- SAT with the total score from Math and
Evidence-Based Reading and Writing

For both CU-AAT (Verbal Section and Math section) and SAT (Math and Evidence - Based Reading and Writing), the results must be from tests taken on the same date.

The score from 1.1.1 and 1.1.2 must be from the tests taken on the same date and must not be taken more than two years prior to the last submission date.

- 1.2 Applicants must have reached a minimum age of 16 years by May 2026.
- 1.3 Applicants are required to maintain proper behavior and strictly adhere to the current and future regulations of the University.

If it is later revealed that the applicant does not meet any of the criteria, or it is found that the information provided in the application is false, or the supporting documents are false or fabricated, the applicant's selection will be revoked for this selection round, even if the applicant has already applied or been selected. Additionally, the applicant may also face criminal prosecution

2. Number of Available Places

The Bachelor of Science in Psychological Science International Program (Joint International Psychology Program) for the Academic Year 2026 (International Admission) will admit up to 15 applicants.

3. Course Structure

The Bachelor of Science in Psychological Science International Program (Joint International Psychology Program) is a four-year program. Students will spend the first two years (4 semesters) at Chulalongkorn University, Thailand, and the following 3 semesters (year 3 and first semester of year 4) at The University of Queensland, Australia, and the final semester at Chulalongkorn University. As per enrollment regulations of the University of Queensland, individuals intending to study at the third to fourth-year level at the University of Queensland must have reached the age to 18 years by May 2028, which represents the year of enrollment at UQ.

4. Admission Schedule and Application Fee

4.1 Application Schedule

There are two rounds of application as follows:

First round application:

December 22, 2025 - February 6, 2026

Second round application: March 20 – May 1, 2026 (The second round of application will take place on the condition that the announced number is not met in the first round.) Prospective applicants can submit their application online through the application portal on the website: https://www.psy.chula.ac.th/en/undergraduate/jipp/admission

4.2 Application Fees

The application fee is 1,000 Baht (transaction fees and surcharges not included).

4.3 Application Fee Payment

For the first-round application, please pay the fee between December 22, 2025 – February 6, 2026. For the second-round application (if any), please pay the fee between March 20 - May 1, 2026. The Applicants may pay application fee of 1,000 Baht using payment information on the website https://www.psy.chula.ac.th/en/undergraduate/jipp/admission.

5. Documents required for the application

Applicants must complete the application form in full and ensure that all provided information is accurate and true. All application forms must be accompanied by the following:

- 5.1 The application form for Academic Year 2026 (International Admission).
- 5.2 One 1-inch photo. The photo must have been taken within the last 6 months, featuring a full straight face, proper attire, and no hat or sunglasses should be worn.
- 5.3 Copies of official diploma or an equivalent document certifying high school graduation, along with the academic transcript.
- 5.4 Exam results as per requirement specified in 1.

 Please enter code 7433 on the College Board website for SAT test scores, or code 7203 on the ETS website for TOEFL test scores, or request the IELTS test center to send the test scores as an electronic copy to the Bachelor of Science Program in Psychological Science (International Program), Faculty of Psychology.
- 5.5 Copy of applicant's passport.
- 5.6 A letter from the educational institution confirming the current student status (for those currently enrolled).
- 5.7 A copy of the proof of payment for application fees with the full name written on it.

Applicants must submit all required documents by uploading them through the online application system.

6. Application Process Details

6.1 First Round Application

6.1.1 Interview Shortlist Announcement

The Faculty of Psychology will consider the list of eligible candidates for the interview based on the applicants' qualifications and test scores specified in Items 1.1.1 and 1.1.2, using the following weighting criteria:

6.1.1.1 English proficiency test scores as specified in Item 1.1.1

6.1.1.2 English proficiency test scores and mathematics aptitude test scores as specified in Item 1.1.2 60%

6.1.2 Interview (Online)

The online interview via Zoom is scheduled to take place between February 16 - 20, 2026. Applicants who do not participate in the interview session will forfeit their opportunity for admission.

6.1.3 Announcement of Applicants who have passed the interview

The Faculty of Psychology will determine the list of applicants who have passed the interview, including the applicants who have passed the interview as reserves based on the applicants' qualifications, the scores specified in Items 1.1.1 and 1.1.2, and the interview scores assessed through English communication, conducted by the Bachelor of Science in Psychological Science (International Program), Faculty of Psychology, Chulalongkorn University. The weighting criteria are as follows:

6.1.3.1 Scores under Items 6.1.1.1 and 6.1.1.2 combined

70%

6.1.3.2 Interview score

30%

Applicants must obtain at least 50% of the total interview score to be considered as having passed the interview. The Faculty of Psychology will announce the list of applicants who have passed the interview on February 24, 2026, on the website https://www.psy.chula.ac.th/en/undergraduate/jipp/admission.

6.1.4 Accepting Offer of Place and Paying the Admission Confirmation Fee

Applicants who have passed the interview must submit their acceptance of the offer and make the admission confirmation fee payment between February 26 – March 3, 2026.

Applicants who have passed the interview as reserves (if any) must submit their acceptance of the offer and make the admission confirmation fee payment between March 4 - 9, 2026. The Faculty of Psychology reserves the right not to refund the admission confirmation fee under any circumstances.

If an applicant fails to do so by the specified time, it will be assumed that they have rejected the offer.

6.1.5 Announcement of Applicants who have accepted the offer and completed the payment of the admission confirmation fee

The Faculty of Psychology will notify applicants who have confirmed their acceptance of the offer of admission and paid for the admission confirmation fee between February 27 – March 10, 2026, on website https://www.psy.chula.ac.th/en/undergraduate/jipp/admission.

Successful applicants who have confirmed their acceptance of the offer of admission and paid the admission confirmation fee will not be eligible for the second-round application.

6.2 Second Round Application (If Any)

The second round of applications will occur if the announced number of candidates is not met in the first round.

6.2.1 Interview Shortlist Announcement

The Faculty of Psychology will consider the list of eligible candidates for the interview based on the applicants' qualifications and test scores specified in Items 1.1.1 and 1.1.2, using the following weighting criteria:

6.2.1.1 English proficiency test scores as specified in Item 1.1.1

40%

6.2.1.2 English proficiency test scores and mathematics aptitude test scores as specified in Item 1.1.2 60%

6.2.2 Interview (Online)

The online interview via Zoom is scheduled to take place between May 11 - 15, 2026. Applicants who do not participate in the interview session will forfeit their opportunity for admission.

6.2.3 Announcement of Applicants who have passed the interview

The Faculty of Psychology will determine the list of applicants who have passed the interview, including the applicants who have passed the interview as reserves based on the applicants' qualifications, the scores specified in Items 1.1.1 and 1.1.2, and the interview scores assessed through English communication, conducted by the Bachelor of Science in Psychological Science (International Program), Faculty of Psychology, Chulalongkorn University. The weighting criteria are as follows:

6.2.3.1 Scores under Items 6.2.1.1 and 6.2.1.2 combined

70%

6.2.3.2 Interview score

30%

Applicants must obtain at least 50% of the total interview score to be considered as having passed the interview. The Faculty of Psychology will announce the list of applicants who have passed the interview on May 19, 2026, on the website https://www.psy.chula.ac.th/en/undergraduate/jipp/admission.

6.2.4 Accepting Offer of Place and Paying the Admission Confirmation Fee

Applicants who have passed the interview must submit their acceptance of the offer and make the admission confirmation fee payment between May 21 – 26, 2026.

Applicants who have passed the interview as reserves (if any) must submit their acceptance of the offer and complete the admission confirmation fee payment



between May 27 – June 1, 2026. The Faculty of Psychology reserves the right not to refund the admission confirmation fee under any circumstances.

If an applicant fails to do so by the specified time, it will be assumed that they have rejected the offer.

6.2.5 Announcement of Applicants who have accepted the offer and completed the payment of the admission confirmation fee

The Faculty of Psychology will notify applicants who have confirmed their acceptance of the offer of admission and paid the admission confirmation fee between May 22 – June 2, 2026, on website

7. Announcement of eligible candidates for enrollment (from the first and second round applications)

Chulalongkorn University will announce the list of eligible candidates for enrollment in the Bachelor of Science in Psychological Science (International Program) for the 2026 academic year (International Admission) on June 10, 2026, on website https://www.psy.chula.ac.th/en/undergraduate/jipp/admission.

8. Conditions of Study

- 8.1 Individuals eligible for the initial registration for enrollment as students at Chulalongkorn University must have successfully completed their education according to the high school curriculum in the sixth year of high school ("Mattayom 6") or its equivalent. If the university later finds that the education was not completed or the qualifications are incomplete as specified, the university will deem the enrollment eligibility as void and reserve the right to withhold the application fee, admission confirmation fee, and tuition fees in all cases. For individuals who have completed their education at international schools in Thailand or abroad that are not accredited by the Ministry of Education, their qualifications must be certified according to the announcements made by the Council of University Presidents of Thailand regarding the criteria for equivalency of educational qualifications to the high school level in the selection process for personal admissions to universities. - 8.2 Those eligible for enrollment as students at Chulalongkorn University after their initial registration have completed the process. If the university later finds that anyone has used false or forged documents for application, selection, or enrollment, their right to study at Chulalongkorn University will be revoked, and they may also face criminal prosecution according to the law.

9. Tuition Fee and Additional Fee

Tuition fees and program fees are determined in accordance with Chulalongkorn University's announcements.
